I. THE ORGANIZER

II. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

1. Discover and promote talented singers.
2. Seek self-expression, creativity and artistic initiative of children, youth and adults.
3. To promote international communication and cooperation between different schools.

III. PLACE AND TIME The competition will be held on 22 December 2022 remotely. Contestants' performances will not be made public in order to protect personal data.

IV. COMPETITION PARTICIPANTS

Students of educational institutions, representatives of national communities from the age of 7 and older, solo singers are invited to participate.

Age groups of participants:

Group A 7-10 years old;

Group B 11-14 years old;

Group C 15-17 years old;

Group D 18-21 years old;

Group E 22-27 years old;

Group F from 28 years old and more.

The participants fee - **30 euros** is paid to Account of the National Center for Education, Culture, Training and Information of National Minorities and Emigrants.

VI. REPERTORY

The singers perform one freely chosen song in the original language (video recording). Duration - up to 8 minutes. Minus instrumental phonograms are used without backing vocals and without a voice duplicating the soloist. The participant can be accompanied by one pianist. As singing will be judged, there cannot be any additional performers, backing vocals, dancers or other musicians. Applications must be completed online until 8 December 2022.

By submitting applications, participants confirm permission to use personal data and submitted videos. Applicants are required to submit a video recording of the song being performed. The application must include a link to the video uploaded online (YouTube).
